Remuneration:	Remuneration will be \$5 per player per week, this will be payable at the end of each season. Typical numbers are 20-30 participants so the expected total remuneration will be approximately \$100-\$150/week. Payment (if applicable) of any additional coaches or helpers will be the responsibility of the NetSetGo Coach.		
Time Commitment	There are 2 seasons of NetSetGO (Apr - Aug and Oct - Dec). Both will run Saturday morning (starting at 8:00 am) for a minimum of 10 - 15 weeks each.

Primary Purpose of Position

- Your role will be to undertake the development and implementation of the NetSetGO program with the view of teaching the registered participants about the basic skills of Netball. NetSetGO is designed for children aged 5 - 8.

Key Responsibilities

- Arrange sessions each week using the online NetSetGO resource pack, recognising what will be of interest and appropriate to the ability and age of the group
- Arrange helpers to assist you each week, depending on number of participants. The coach must maintain at least 1 adult per 10 children with 1 helper (this can be an older child)
- Assist NetSetGO Coordinator with administration of the NetSetGo online registrations, queries and participation certificates

- Have completed a Foundation level coaching coach
- Experience coaching young junior netballers
- Completion of online NetSetGO module
- Strong understanding of the NetSetGO training / activities program
