Valley Netball is committed to helping coaches develop their coaching education and accreditation. In addition to the payments below, Valley Netball will pay a minimum of half of any costs for further education/accreditation our coaches wish to complete during the year. Approval of the courses needs to be obtained from the Valley Netball committee prior to completion.

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Coaches Code of Ethics:

1. Respect the right, dignity and worth of every human being
 - Within the context of the activity, treat everyone equally regardless of gender, ethnic origin, or religion
2. Ensure the players time with you is a positive and rewarding experience
 - All players are deserving of equal attention and opportunities
3. Treat each player as an individual
 - Respect the talent, development stage and goals of each player
 - Help each player reach their full potential.
4. Be fair, considerate, and honest with players.
5. Be professional and accept responsibility for your actions.
 - Display a high standard in your language, manner, punctuality, preparation, and presentation.
 - Display control, respect dignity and professionalism to all involved in Netball including opposition teams and umpires.
 - Encourage the players to display the same qualities.
6. Commit to the providing of a quality service to your players.
 - Maintain or improve your current level of accreditation.
 - Seek continual improvements through performance approval and ongoing coach education.
 - Provide a training program which is planned and sequential.
 - Maintain appropriate records.
7. Operate within the rules, guidelines, and the spirit of the sport of Netball.
 - Abide by the Rules and Regulations of Netball Australia and the Association by-laws
 - Adhere to Netball Victoria Coach Code of Behavior

8. Refrain from any form of personal abuse towards your players.
 - This includes verbal and physical abuse.
 - Be alert to any forms of abuse directed towards your players whilst they are in your care.
9. Refrain from any form of harassment towards your players.
 - This includes sexual and racial harassment, racial vilification, and harassment on the grounds of disability.
10. Provide a safe environment for training and competition and do not expose players to unnecessary risks.
 - Ensure equipment used and facilities meet safety standards
 - Ensure equipment, training and the environment are appropriate to the age, level of fitness and skill of the player.
11. Show concern and caution towards sick and injured players.
 - Provide a modified training program where appropriate.
 - Allow further participation in training and Competition only when appropriate, based on medical advice.
 - Encourage players to seek medical advice.
12. Be a positive role model for the sport of Netball and all athletes.



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
