



LYVNA NIGHT COMPETITIONS - RULES

The Lilydale & Yarra Valley Netball Association ("LYVNA") Night Competition provides women's and mixed teams of various ages the opportunity to participate socially with friends, family, and peers in a division suited to their playing level. This is an open age competition for players aged 14 years and over.

FEES

- A team entry fee is payable each term via Netball Connect to secure your place in the competition.
- A weekly game fee is payable at the competition office before your match (EFT or cash).
- All fees are reviewed annually.
- Forfeit fees may be payable

All team fees and forfeit fees must be paid before taking the court.

Player Insurance

- \$15 per player (if you do not have a current Netball Victoria membership)
- \$0 (if you already hold a current Netball Victoria membership through another competition)
- *Single Game Vouchers are not accepted for night competitions.*

REGISTRATION

- Team Managers register their team using the link provided by LYVNA.
- Team Managers send registration invitations to all players.
- All players must be registered to a team to participate and to be covered by insurance.
- Players may register to more than one team, however game times cannot be guaranteed to avoid clashes.
- Fill-ins must be registered to at least one team.
- All umpires must be registered to the competition they are officiating in.

UNIFORM

Players

- Uniforms must be appropriate and not revealing.
- Shorts must be sporting style, with no zips or pockets.
- Nails must be short and smooth; if long, they must be taped with *soft* tape (no rigid or paper tape).
- All jewellery must be removed or securely taped.
- Approved netball gloves may be worn, but nails must still be taped underneath.
- Teams must wear matching tops and matching bottoms (most choose black; bib colours differ).
- Acceptable items: singlets, T-shirts, long sleeves, skirts, shorts, tights, leggings.
 - Hoodies may be worn in cooler weather, but hoods must be tucked in.

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- Not allowed: loose-strap singlets, muscle tops, sports bras as tops, shorts with loose pockets.
 - Correct sports footwear must be worn.
 - Bibs are provided, but teams may bring their own (inform the coordinator).
 - Players must not wear anything that could endanger themselves or others.
 - Medical alert bracelets may be worn if taped.
 - Hair must be tied back.
 - Repeated breaches of uniform rules may result in a player being unable to take the court.

Umpires

- Umpires must wear comfortable attire with a white top.
- No revealing clothing.

GRADING

- Competitions are graded into Divisions/Sections 1–5 based on team numbers and performance.
- Regrading may occur after Rounds 1, 2, or 3.
- Teams will be emailed if regraded; however, checking the fixture weekly is the team's responsibility.
- Concerns may be emailed to nightnetball@lyvna.com.au (include your team name).

BYES

Due to uneven section numbers, some fixtures may require byes to fulfil the draw.

FORFEITS

- Forfeits should be a last resort.
- A team may take the court with a minimum of 5 players.
 - The opposition will receive 1 goal per minute until your team takes the court.
 - A forfeit will be declared if a team cannot take the court by the start of the second quarter.
- The non-forfeiting team receives 4 points.
- Forfeit Fees:
 - \$80 (first forfeit)
 - \$130 (second and subsequent forfeits)
- Notify the competition organiser as early as possible so umpires and opponents can be informed.

WITHDRAWALS

- Teams withdrawing during the term may incur a charge.
- No refunds are available on any fees paid.
- Player refunds are managed internally by the Team Manager.
- Draws and ladders will be adjusted at LYVNA's discretion for withdrawn teams.

TEAM MANAGERS

Each team must appoint a Team Manager aged 14+. Responsibilities include:

- Registering the team.
- Ensuring all fees are paid on time.

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- Ensuring all players are registered prior to playing.
 - Ensuring players meet age requirements.
 - Ensuring all players understand and follow all competition rules and the Netball Victoria Code of Behaviour.
 - Informing players of game times and changes.

Pre-game requirements

The Team Manager must visit the office 10–15 minutes before the game to:

- Pay the team's weekly fee.
- Check off players on the team sheet and add fill-ins if needed.
- Add new players to Netball Connect and the office sheet (have their details ready).
- Collect bibs.
- Collect scoresheet (if the home team).

TEAM NAMES

LYVNA may reject any team name that is offensive, implies inappropriate language, or breaches accepted standards.

UMPIRES

- Umpires are provided by the competition.
- Umpires provide a game ball.
- An umpire convenor is on-site both nights.
- Umpires' decisions regarding uniform, nails, taping, etc., are final.
- Arguing with umpires is unacceptable.
 - For serious concerns, call for the umpire convenor immediately.
- Players may respectfully ask an umpire for a rule clarification at half time or after the game.
- Disputing decisions will not be tolerated.

COMPETITION COORDINATORS

- Communicate with Team Managers via email or phone.
- May adjust rules to ensure competition quality; all changes will be communicated.
- Players sent off may face further disciplinary action.
- Repeated foul language or aggressive behaviour may result in removal from the competition.

CHILD SAFETY

- LYVNA is a Child Safe Organisation and follows Netball Victoria's child protection standards.

CODES OF CONDUCT

- Team Managers are responsible for team and spectator behaviour.
- Unacceptable behaviour—including disrespect, foul language, or poor sportsmanship—may result in removal of players or spectators.

PHOTOGRAPHY

FIRST AID

- No qualified first aid officer is present at night competitions.
- Coordinators and the umpire convenor can provide basic first aid supplies.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

- Players must be 14 years old before taking the court.
- All players must be registered in Netball Connect.
- No Single Game Vouchers are permitted.
- Players may play multiple games per night but only one game per timeslot.

MIXED COMPETITION PLAYER REQUIREMENTS

LYVNA observes the Netball Victoria Gender Regulation in regard to mixed competition:

- There is no minimum number of male players required in a team.
- A mixed team may have a maximum of three male players on court at any one time.
- A mixed team may only have one male player in each third of the court.

For clarity, this means:

- **Defence Third:** One male player may occupy either Goal Keeper (GK) or Goal Defence (GD).
- **Mid Third:** One male player may occupy either Centre (C), Wing Attack (WA) or Wing Defence (WD).
- **Goal Third:** One male player may occupy either Goal Attack (GA) or Goal Shooter (GS).

These requirements apply in accordance with LYVNA mixed competition bylaws. Source: LYVNA Bylaws (20 February 2026) – 9. Inclusive Environments, Item #9.7.

FILL INS

- Requests may be posted on the [LYVNA NIGHT COMP](#) Facebook group.
- Fill ins must be registered to at least one team.
- Fill ins must record their name and registered team on the scoresheet.

MATCH RULES

- Four × 10-minute quarters.
- 2-minute half time, 1-minute quarter breaks.
- Central timing system.
- Match lengths may be adjusted if required (e.g., weather, injuries).

SCORING

- Each team must supply a scorer aged 14+.
- Home team collects the scoresheet.
- Home scorer marks the official sheet; away scorer must sit with them.
- First Named team returns the scoresheet immediately after the game.

FINALS

- Finals are held in the last week of term.
- Top two teams in each division compete for medals.
- All other teams also play in finals week.
- If teams are tied for competitions points, the finals positions will be determined by the team with highest goal percentage during the term
- Each finals match includes a Best on Court award.

Finals Extra Time Procedure

If scores are tied:

1. 1-minute break.
2. Teams change ends.
3. Two × 5-minute halves are played with no break between halves.
4. If still drawn, play continues until a team leads by two goals.

LYVNA may modify finals formats as needed.

ROLLING SUBSTITUTIONS

- One substitution at a time.
- Can occur during play, stoppages, or intervals.
- No need to notify umpires.
- Incoming player may only enter once the exiting player has fully left the court and tagged hands.
- Incoming player must already be wearing the correct bib.
- Substitutions occur at the yellow markers near each team bench.

FIXTURES & LADDERS

- Available on www.lyvna.com.au and Netball Connect app.
- Check weekly for changes and regrading.
- Full-term draw is released after grading.
